**Principals and Partners:** Fellow Members engaged in the practice of public accounting as individual practitioners, partners or shareholders in professional corporations.

**Staff:** Fellow Members engaged in the practice of public accounting as employees.

The TSCPA Council has established the following annual membership dues schedule. Annual dues are payable by members as follows. Dues are prorated quarterly for members joining after the first quarter.

**Affiliate:** \$250

**Emerging Professional:** \$55

**Provisional:** \$250

**Fellow members licensed for 5 years or more:** \$270 (excludes educators, inactive and retired)

**Fellow members licensed less than 5 years:** \$250 (excludes educators, inactive and retired)

**Educators:** \$95

**Professional Leave:** \$75

**Retired:** \$75

## Chapter Dues Code Description
